

Description

The Southeastern Trauma Symposium is a two-day conference designed to include interests of all trauma care professionals. The conference addresses the clinical management of the trauma patient beginning with pre-hospital resuscitation through acute care and rehabilitation services. National and local experts will present the most current concepts in trauma care. A variety of presentation formats (didactic with lecture, small group tracks, etc.) will be utilized throughout the symposium.

SYMPOSIUM OBJECTIVES

Following this symposium, the trauma care provider will be able to:

1. List current trends and advances in management of the trauma patient.
2. List current trends in the care of the burn patient.
3. Evaluate case studies and lessons learned in providing quality trauma care
4. Discuss issues surrounding domestic violence in the trauma victim.
